Commissioner Brown called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Commissioner Brown turned the proceedings over to Randy Soriano, Township Manager.

NOTIFICATION

Mr. Soriano informed the attendees that all sessions of the Salisbury Township Board of Commissioners regular meetings are recorded electronically for the purpose of taking the Minutes. All public comments on agenda items will be taken prior to the vote. All public comments related to non-agenda items will be taken after the agenda has been satisfied.

Mr. Soriano announced that the Township records the meetings and archives its tapes and records are available pursuant to the Right-to-Know Law, if requested.

Mr. Soriano reminded everyone of the three minute rule and asked that anyone who wishes to speak come to the podium, sign in, announce oneself, and speak clearly into the microphone. Mr. Soriano added that the speaker can choose not to list his/her address; however, it is preferred that the speaker announce if he or she is a Township resident. He noted that if a resident does not divulge his or her address, it will impair the Township administrative follow-ups on a particular issue.

FINANCIAL REPORT AND LIST OF BILLS PAYABLE

Commissioner Brinton inquired about the reason for the property tax refunds and reimbursements and the way they are calculated. Ms. Bonaskiewich stated that the total amount refunded is split across the General, Fire and Library Funds due to the resident's assessment being lowered through the appeal process.

Commissioner Brinton inquired about a "reimbursement" invoice from Keystone Consulting Engineers. Mr. Tettemer stated that it is basically a pass-through invoice in which Keystone reviewed the Developer's plan, billed the Township, and the Township in turn billed the Developer. He noted that the Developer will then pay the Township and the Township will pay Keystone.

Commissioner Ackerman questioned the invoice from C & M Gutters and Guards. Mr. Andreas explained that it was for the cleaning of the gutters at the Municipal Building because the Township does not have the type of equipment needed to do the work. Commissioner Ackerman inquired about obtaining estimates for the work. Mr. Soriano explained that because it is such a nominal amount of money, the need for estimates is unnecessary.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Mr. Soriano announced that the new Township map, developed through Municipal Aid Publications, is on hold at the moment due to the fact that the Zoning Ordinance has not been finalized.

Mr. Soriano brought up the Scrap Metal Policy and how the proceeds are distributed. He noted the practice has been that the money is split between the employees of the Public Works Department, which comes out to approximately \$100 at the end of year. Commissioner Ackerman suggested revising the practice each year as the situation arises.

Mr. Soriano commented that a decision still needs to be made about retirement incentives for the Public Works Department.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

Commissioner Ackerman inquired about the Township's salt supply. Mr. Andreas stated that they currently have about 300 tons of material in the shed with another 350 tons that is already ordered.

Commissioner Martucci brought forth praise from a resident for the snow plowing efforts of the Public Works Department.

Commissioner Martucci stated that he received a phone call from the USDA about the goose program at Laubach Park and whether the Township wanted to continue. Commissioner Martucci suggested doing a maintenance program at a reduced cost. It was the consensus of the Board to continue the efforts with a maintenance program.

Commissioner Brinton stated that on February 13th, the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency is having a class in Macungie and noted that she and Commissioner Ackerman have both signed up for the class and will not be able to attend the Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners that is also scheduled for that night.

Commissioner Seagreaves stated that he received a call from Mr. Paul Bruchak at 1225 East Emmaus Avenue who expressed concerns about accidents in that area. Sergeant Soberick stated that other than two recent accidents, there has not been an issue on that road that would require attention from the Police. Commissioner Brown recalled a traffic study performed in that area a couple years ago and thought the results were inconclusive. Mr. Bruchak was present to address Board and stated that he is concerned about the increased traffic and the speed of the cars. It was the consensus of the Board to have the Chief to look into the situation and get back to Mr. Bruchak. Commissioner Brown also noted that it is a PennDOT road and the Township would not have jurisdiction to install stop signs or red lights.

Commissioner Brown announced that there will be an Executive Session held after the Workshop meeting to address personnel matters.

ADJOURNMENT

Commissioner Martucci made a Motion to adjourn the Meeting, seconded by Commissioner Brinton. The time was 8:25 p.m.

Ordinance No. 02-2014-<u>585</u>

(Duly Adopted February 13, 2014)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, PART 6(A) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES (RELATING TO POLICE PENSION PLAN) BY AMENDING SECTION 602(5)(B) TO COMPLY WITH MINIMUM SERVICE-RELATED DISABILITY PENSION REQUIREMENTS UNDER ACT 600 OF 1955, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ("Board") of the Township of Salisbury, Lehigh County ("Township") has established and maintained a Police Pension Plan and Police Pension Fund (the "Plan"), a defined benefit pension plan for the full-time police officers of the Township pursuant to Act 600 of 1955 as amended, 53 PA. STAT. ANN. §§ 767-778 ("Act 600"). The terms and conditions of the Plan are codified in Chapter 1, Part 6(A) of the Township's Code of Ordinances, as amended through the date of this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 01-2013-581 adopted January 10, 2013, the Board recently amended the Plan to conform to provisions of collective bargaining agreements ("CBAs") between the Township and the Salisbury Township Police Officers Association ("Association"); and

WHEREAS, in a recent audit of the Plan, the Department of the Auditor General questioned the provision of the Plan related to service-related disability benefits as recently amended to conform to past and current CBAs, in that the Plan provides a benefit equal to 75% of final 36-month average monthly compensation while Act 600 requires a minimum benefit of 50% of monthly salary at the time the disability was incurred; and

WHEREAS, although the Plan's current disability benefit will generally be greater than the minimum required under Act 600, there are potential situations under which the Plan's benefit will not satisfy the statutory minimum; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend the Plan to insure that the service-related disability benefit is not less than the statutory minimum; and

WHEREAS, the Association has approved this amendment; and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of this Ordinance the Board reviewed a cost estimate of the effect of the changes made herein prepared by the actuarial firm Beyer-Barber in accordance with Section 305 of the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act, 53 PA. STAT. ANN. § 895.305;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Salisbury, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, that Chapter 1, Part 6(A) of the Code of Ordinances (relating to Police Pension Plan) is amended by amending § 602(5)(B) as follows (with additions indicated by <u>double-underlining</u>, and deletions indicated by <u>stricken through</u> type), effective immediately:

§ 602. Retirement Requirements and Benefits.

* * *

5. Disability Retirement Benefit.

* * *

B. In the event of permanent and total service-related disability, benefits shall become payable to an injured police officer each month in an amount equal to 75% of the Compensation paid to the officer as a full-time police officer during the last thirty-six (36)

months of service immediately preceding the officer's last day of actual service, divided by thirty-six (36) (or, if greater, 50% of the police officer's monthly salary at the time the disability was incurred), provided that the police officer who receives benefits for the same injuries under the Social Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. § 301 et seq.) shall have the disability benefit offset or reduced by the amount of such Social Security benefits. For purposes of this subparagraph (B) alone and not for the purposes of Section 602(2) or any other section of this Plan, and without any effect on the definition of the term "Compensation", a police officer's "monthly salary" on a given date is the officer's base hourly rate of compensation as of that date (without any premium for shift differential, overtime, special duty pay, or any other premium or multiplier), multiplied by 2080 and divided by 12.
