Therefore, the members discussed the year's accomplishments on a month-to-month basis and its process. Discussion ensued with the NRI from the NRI draft to finalization, Walking Purchase Park Clean-ups and the Rain Barrel Workshop. They discussed the conferences that some members were able to attend. They discussed their pending projects, such as, the creation of the Standard Operating Procedures for the website and the Memorial Tree Plantings. They concluded with topics of interest for future projects, e.g. battery collection and E-cycling of electronics.

Ms. Sopka stated that the members should evaluate the Environmental portion of the Comprehensive Plan to be sure it depicts the value of Salisbury Township relative to the region referenced in the NRI because it will be the guideline for the next 10 years. Ms. Sopka stated an example would be to focus on certain locations within the Township that need protection and recognizing that they are valuable resources, e.g. headwaters, vernal pools, springs and seeps, etc.
