#### **Old Business:**

- 1. Salisbury Township Storm water Basin Retrofit: UPDATE
  - The project has been moving slowly however the silt sox has been installed to prevent dirty water from leaving the basin.
  - Some of the dead trees have been removed
  - The fencing has been removed.
  - Reworking the area for proposed seating has started relocation of large stones and grading of the site has been conducted.
  - Excavation of the basin has slowed due to the accumulation of water in the basin. Excavation will resume when the basin is dry.

#### **New Business:**

- 1. The Salisbury Township EAC would like to open discussion with residents regarding storm water
- 2. Mr. Sandy Nicolo, MS4 Coordinator for Salisbury Township has requested that the EAC make a formal adoption of the Plan Development of the MS4 Public Education and Outreach and Public Participation/Involvement Program. It is anticipated the EAC will take action during the meeting.

  - iv. Planting grasses in the seating area
