REPORT OF OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

1. Zoning Hearing Board – The ZHB reviewed the final revisions on 87 Chestnut Hill Appeal regarding steep slopes and siting of the home and driveway. The ZHB approved the recommended changes.

The ZHB heard the appeal of an enforcement proceeding regarding 2120 W Mosser St. regarding various violations occurring on the site. The Zoning Hearing Board members agreed the violations needed to be corrected and verified by the Zoning Officer to be sure the violations were addressed.

NEW BUSINESS:

- STEAC representation at the Eastern Salisbury Fire Department Community Day was held on October 7th from 11 AM to 3 PM. Kathy Velekei and Karen El Chaar were available at the event.
- Salisbury Township budgeted funds for the Watershed Enviroscope and the respective carrying case. The order was submitted to the company and we expect the Watershed Enviroscope will assist the EAC with educating students on the impacts of Stormwater in our environment and community. The items are currently at the Township Zoning/Planning department.
