## § 15-217. Skates, Coasters, Sleds, Skateboards and Other Toy Vehicles. [Ord. 11-88-303, 11/22/1988]

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride on a sled upon any sidewalk in the Township. Provided: nothing in this subsection shall prevent a pedestrian from pulling a sled, with or without a rider, upon a sidewalk.
- 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in roller skating or to ride upon or propel any coaster, skateboard or other toy vehicle upon:
  - A. Any street except in order to cross the roadway; or
  - B. Any sidewalk located in a business district, except that nothing in this subsection shall prevent a pedestrian from pulling a coaster or other toy vehicle, with or without a rider, upon a sidewalk.
- 3. Any person who violates any provision of this § 15-220 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$5 and costs.
