APPLICANT CERTIFICATION

The undersigned applicant / excavator agrees to reimburse the Township of Salisbury for any and all costs and expenses incurred by the Township in connection with this permit and the work conducted thereunder, including, but not limited to, enforcing the requirements of state law and conditions of this permit, inspections made to assure compliance therewith, and enforcement measures taken by the Township to protect the public where the applicant and or contractor has failed to comply therewith including police details and other safety or remedial measures deemed necessary by the Township. The undersigned applicant / excavator agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Township and all of its agents and employees from any and all liability, causes or action, costs and expenses resulting from or arising out of any injury, death, loss, or damage to any person or property during the work conducted under this permit. The undersigned hereby certifies that they have read and examined this application and that the proposed work is accurately represented in the statements made in this application and that all work shall be executed in accordance with the terms and conditions of said permits, the Township of Salisbury Standard Policy for Road Opening Permits, Salisbury’s Road Repair Specifications, Township Ordinances and all other applicable laws in effect and understand that deviations from the approved permit requirements shall result in immediate revocation of the permit and require immediate restoration of disturbed area to pre-construction conditions. The permittee shall guarantee the integrity of the opening excavation for 12 months from the time it is permanently restored and shall be responsible for all costs related thereto. The permittee shall make all repairs during the warranty period caused by settling, heaving, or cracking.

Storm Water Management

I understand that any excavation resulting in dirt, mud, or any other materials that leave the construction area and enter a neighboring property and/or the Township separate storm water sewer system and waters of the Commonwealth is a violation of the Salisbury Township Private Property Maintenance Ordinance. I also am aware that certain disturbances of materials may require additional approval from agencies outside of Salisbury Township.

I understand that I am responsible to place erosion and sediment controls around the excavation area before an excavation to prevent materials from leaving the construction area in accordance with all applicable Ordinances, Statutes and Regulations.

I understand that I am responsible to maintain installed erosion and sediment controls for the duration of the project.

I understand that a violation of this section will result in a stop work order and possible fines.
