He noted that Disruptive Conduct Ordinance will help and suggested including group homes in with language in the ordinance.

Ms. Bonaskiewich commented that she has been in discussions with Chief Soberick regarding the issue and noted that they will bring the Disruptive Conduct Ordinance back to the Board for discussion, but there has to be language that includes facilities such as group homes.

A discussion ensued regarding who governs group homes.
