ORDINANCE NO. 09-2022-654

BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SALISBURY, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 503 OF CHAPTER 1, PART 5 ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ESTABLISH THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO CHANGE PATROLMAN TO "PATROL OFFICER"

WHEREAS, pursuant to the First-Class Township Code, the Township is able to establish the rank of officers of the police department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Salisbury, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the same that Chapter 1, Part 5, Section 503 of the Salisbury Township Code of Ordinances, hereby is amended to include the rank of lieutenant and the rank of Patrolman changed to Patrol Officer as follows:

<u>ARTICLE I.</u> Chapter 1, Part 5, Section 503 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:

§503. Ranks

The ranks of the Police Department are hereby established as follows:

- Patrolman Patrol Officer
- Sergeant
- Detective
- Corporal
- Lieutenant

ARTICLE II. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
